Update to Residents: COVID-19 Prevention and Management Measures

As you can probably tell from the news, information on the COVID-19 virus changes daily, as organizations continue to find better means to stop the spread of the disease. We are constantly monitoring information from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, Indiana State Department of Health and Marion County Department of Health for the best means to keep our residents and staff safe.

Previously at the Governor's guidance, we asked each resident to remain in their home and limit visits to stores or other offsite locations. Today we are told that ISDH recommendations are for residents to leave their home only for medical necessity. This would include a doctor's appointment or offsite treatment. Grocery shopping is considered a necessity – although please remember that we will also shop for you on Mondays and deliver your food to your door.

We are eliminating gatherings in the lobby of Tamarack entirely. Please call the front desk to check on anticipated deliveries. We ask you not to come and wait in the lobby. As a reminder, perishable items will be delivered to your door immediately – and boxed items will be held for 72 hours before delivery.

If you wish to get fresh air outside, we ask those residents who live on the first floor to exit and enter through their patio door. Others may go out other doors but must come back through door #1 in the Tamarack lobby. Please walk alone and/or practice safe distancing of 6'.
